The earthquake in Turkey

In the last few weeks, a massive earthquake hit Turkey and has already killed hundreds of people and completely destroyed whole cities. We are going to be looking at what caused the earthquake, and why it was so destructive.

What caused it?

The Earth's crust is made up of several plates, and one of them (in our case the Arabian plate) started moving to the north and hit the Anatolian plate, which caused pressure and led to movement on the surface of Earth. As it is described in the picture, the earthquake was caused by a strikeslip fault.

USA shooting down UFOs?!

EASTER ISLAND

Easter Island is located in the Eastern Pacific Ocean and is a special territory of Chile. The island is most famous for its monumental statues, called moai.

The first European who reached the island was the Dutch admiral Jacob Roggeveen in 1722. He found a mixed population that worshiped the moai statues. The native population was estimated to be around 3000 people. As the island was being discovered more, some diseases were brought and the population was reduced to 111 people. In 1888 the island was annexed to Chile, which leased nearly

all of the island territory for sheep raising.

Moai statues are human figures carved by the Rapa Nui people between the years 1250 and 1500. Almost all of them have gigantic heads and no bodies. Many archeologists suggest that they symbolize authority and power. Some studies show that quarrying of the moai might be related to improving soil fertility. The real symbolism is not known yet. There is a huge mystery about how the statues were



transported around the island, because some of them weigh up to 14 tons. More and more statues are still being discovered. In 2022 there was a fire that tore through part of Easter Island affecting nearly 60 hectars and some of the statues.
