



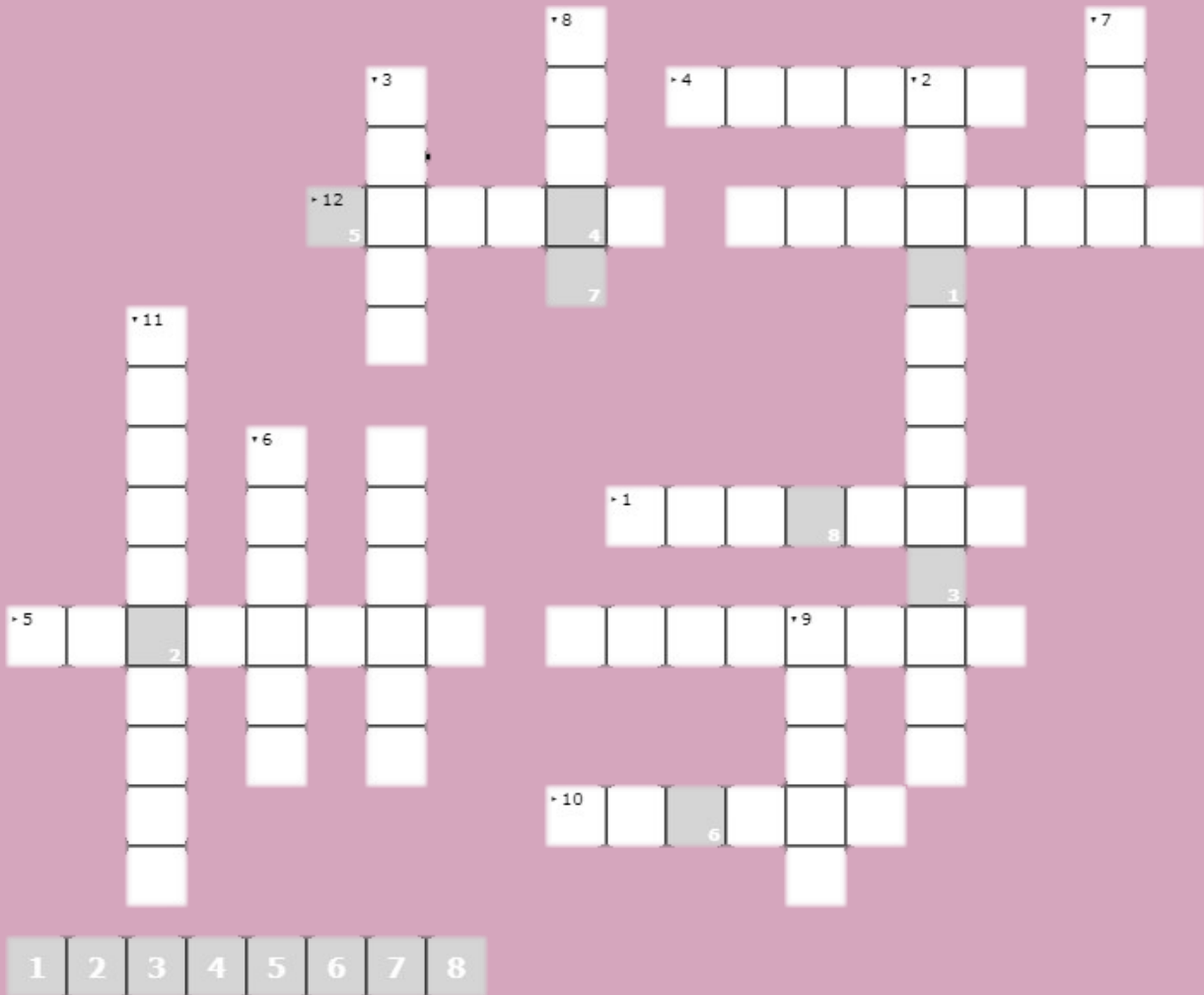

# THANKSGIVING IN THE USA

- it is a federal holiday in the United States celebrated on the fourth Thursday of November

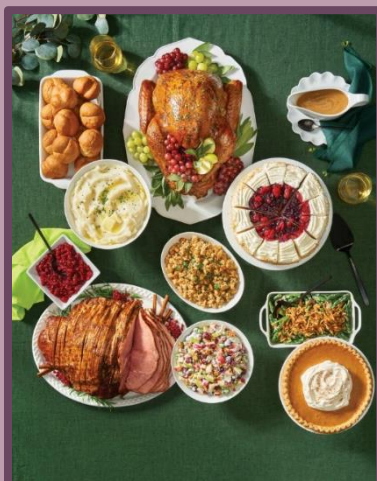
## HISTORY

The event that Americans commonly call the "first Thanksgiving" was celebrated by the Pilgrims (the first people who came from Britain to America) after their first harvest in the New World in October 1621. This feast lasted three days and was attended by 90 Native American Wampanoag people and 53 survivors of the Mayflower (Pilgrims). For more than two centuries, days of Thanksgiving were celebrated by individual colonies and states. It wasn't until 1863, in the midst of the Civil War, that President Abraham Lincoln proclaimed a national Thanksgiving Day to be held each November.



## TRADITIONS

On the Thanksgiving morning, many people wake up early to run in local races (often for charity) called turkey trots. Other folks watch a Thanksgiving parade in person or on television. The largest and most iconic parade is the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade in New York City.



Many families watch NFL or other football games (college and high school) at home as a tradition.

The dinner traditionally consists of a turkey, potatoes (mashed or sweet), corn, cranberries and pumpkin pie.

## CRITICISM



Some Americans (including people of Native American ancestry) believe Thanksgiving celebrations mask the true history of oppression and bloodshed that underlies the relationship between European settlers and Native Americans. Sometimes it is called “National Day of Mourning”

# November 17, 1989

The Velvet Revolution was a non-violent political revolution that took place from 17 November to 28 November 1989. This revolution ultimately led to the overthrow of the communist government in the country.

The Velvet Revolution was largely characterized by peaceful protests, demonstrations, and civil disobedience against the ruling Communist Party of Czechoslovak Socialist Republic. The impulse for the revolution was a series of events, including the fall of the Berlin Wall in East Germany and the growing discontent among the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic population with the oppressive communist regime.

One of the key figures in the Velvet Revolution was Václav Havel a dissident, playwright and political activist, who became the leader of the opposition movement. As the protests continued to grow in size and intensity, the communist government eventually gave in to the demands of the demonstrators.

On December 10, 1989, Czechoslovak Socialist Republic President Gustav Husák appointed a new government that included non-communist members, later on Václav Havel was elected as the president by the Federal Assembly. This marked a peaceful transition of power and the end of 41 years of communist rule in Czechoslovakia.

The Velvet Revolution is notable for its non-violent nature, in contrast to many other revolutions and uprisings in history. It demonstrated the power of peaceful protests and civil disobedience in bringing about political change. After the revolution, Czechoslovak Socialist Republic transitioned to a democratic government and eventually split into two separate countries, the Czech Republic and Slovakia, in 1993.
