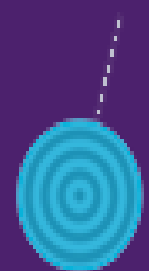
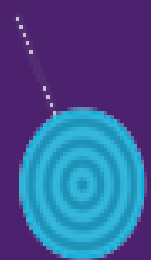


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THE CONTROVERSY BEHIND P. DIDDY

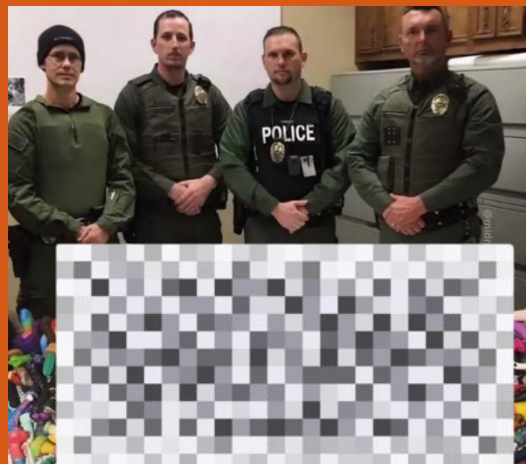
Music legend Sean "Diddy" Combs has been arrested on charges of sex trafficking, with accusations spanning years. A recent raid on his homes uncovered shocking evidence: 784 sex toys, over 1,000 bottles of lubricant, a 50-foot bed, firearms, and ammunition. These findings are tied to claims that Diddy organized "freak-offs" — illegal sex parties involving forced individuals, where he allegedly filmed the encounters.



Ex-girlfriend Cassie Ventura's lawsuit, filed earlier this year, details a history of abuse during their relationship, which lasted from 2007 to 2018. Ventura accused Diddy of physically assaulting her, controlling her through drugs, and forcing her into sexual acts with others. These events are said to have occurred regularly at hotels and Diddy's residences, where he allegedly used his power to manipulate those involved.



The case has become more severe as other people have come forward with similar accusations, including claims of violence and threats. One of the most surprising moments involves Diddy threatening to blow up rapper Kid Cudi's car when he found out about his ex-girlfriend's relationship with the rapper, an incident later confirmed when Cudi's car mysteriously exploded. As the investigation continues, more shocking details will come out, giving us insight on a history of abusive behaviour that has remained hidden for years in the industry.



Regarding Diddy's scandal, the internet has been quick to make memes. Many have taken to calling him "The Diddler," playing on his stage name. Jokes have emerged about the excessive 784 sex toys found in his home, with jokes like, "The Diddler done diddled his last diddle." Social media has been flooded with memes mixing his reputation of a mob boss with the bizarre details of the case, with dark humour often being used too.

Marthy's KITCHEN



Marthy's kitchen – Masarykovo nábřeží 6 brunch spot

This is one of my favorite brunch spots in all of Prague. It is just a 3 minute walk from our school. They offer a large variety of sweet and savoury breakfast foods. They also serve really good coffee, teas and homemade lemonades.

Cafe Mosaic – Odborů 4 coffee shop

This cafe is located in the Mosaic House Design Hotel, which was a former theatre. Its unique interior design will definitely catch your eye and it is only a few minutes walk from the school.





I Need Coffee! – Na Moráni 1958 coffee shop

The name speaks for itself. This place is ideal for a quick grab and go coffee in the morning. Alongside with the coffee you can also get yourself a little sweet treat like cookies or brownies.



Café Savoy – Vítězná 5 brunch spot

This is an elegant café with wooden interior reminiscent of the First Republic, located on the other side of the Vltava River. This one is more on the pricey side, but their food is delicious and they serve premium coffee. This place is also a part of the ambiente chain.



Oktoberfest

The Oktoberfest festival originated on October 12 1810, in celebration of the marriage of the crown prince of Bavaria, who later became king Louis I, to Princess Therese von Sachsen Hildburghausen. The festival concluded five days later with a horse race held in an open area that came to be called Theresienwiese ("Therese's green"). In 2024, the 189th Oktoberfest will take place on the Theresienwiese from September 21 to October 6 2024.



The Oktoberfest doesn't cost to enter; anyone can wander through the venue without needing a ticket. The reason there are sometimes queues at the entrance is that security personnel check visitors' bags so that everyone at the Oktoberfest can feel safe and relax.

PRICE LIST:

The beer price for Oktoberfest 2024 is between 13.60 euros and 15.30 euros.

The average price per litre for non-alcoholic beverages is: 10.48 euros for table water, 12.23 euros for sparkling water and 11.67 euros for lemonade.



WHAT TO WEAR TO OKTOBERFEST

Unlike other festivals around the world Munich's Oktoberfest is an easy one to dress for, with the burden of outfit selection taken away from us and replaced with two of our new favourite German words, *Dirndl* and *Lederhosen*.

Dirndls, for women, and *Lederhosen* for men and some women, make up Munich's Oktoberfest *Trachten*, or traditional costumes, and with well more than 90% of revellers in the beer halls sporting some kind of Oktoberfest *Dirndl* or *Lederhosen*, for even the short-term visitor an investment in some Oktoberfest outfits can really enhance the experience.



FUN FACTS:

Beer

Oktoberfest beer is stronger than normal beer, at around 6%. The variety is called Märzen as it is brewed in March and allowed to age so that it is ready to drink by late summer.

Munich beer only

Oktoberfest is, above all, a celebration of Bavarian traditions, so the only beer you'll find during the festival is brewed within the city limits of Munich. Only beers that fit these criteria are considered Oktoberfest Beers.

Signal festival
